Mochi sales: You will have a chance to purchase the homemade mochi that comes in five flavors: anko (red bean paste), kinako (sweet soybean flour), shoyu-nori (soy sauce & seaweed), sato-jyoyu (sweet soy sauce) and daikon-oroshi (grated horse radish) at \$3 per plate. Oshiruko (sweet red bean soup with mochi) and Zoni (broth with mixed vegetable and mochi) is \$3 per bowl. All funds will directly support the St. Louis Nihongo Kyoshitsu.
